Greetings and love !!!

I am writing in a season of profound spiritual urgency. As we walk through one of the most draining, scarce, and pressurized periods, the Spirit of the Lord continues to speak clearly and persistently: **“Expand your faith. Obey My Word.”**

In moments where human strength feels insufficient, God reminds us that His work advances not through visible resources, but through faith-filled obedience.

Last week, our team witnessed a move of God in Dang and Nepalgunj that defied human logic. After three days of leadership gatherings with more than 400 key leaders (January 11–13) and commissioning 23 graduates from our Bible school (CLS), we entered a series of powerful outreach meetings and leadership training across Dang and Bardiya.

On the morning of January 17, we arrived in Nepalgunj to lead the weekend church service. There, God stirred hearts deeply and led our congregation into the next step of His mission. Despite their own economic hardship, our local believers responded with extraordinary faith.

They pledged NRs. 1.25 million, and more than 100 volunteers committed their physical labor to help build the Karnali Outreach Mission Center (KOMC) in Dailekh.

The local church is already giving the sweat and the seed. Their sacrifice is a testimony of faith that humbles and inspires us. At this critical stage, we are prayerfully seeking strategic partners who can stand with us to provide the foundational infrastructure needed to establish this mission center in one of the most unreached and economically poorest regions of Nepal.

We believe this is a God-appointed moment to bring lasting spiritual transformation to the Karnali region, and we invite you to prayerfully consider partnering with us in this Kingdom assignment.

Why This Mission Matters:

Karnali Province remains:

- One of the spiritually darkest regions of Nepal

- The economically poorest province of the country
- Among the most unreached mission fields

Yet God has opened a clear and urgent window, and His people are already responding with faith, sacrifice, and action. By establishing a permanent base with clean water, secure boundaries, and a dedicated training hall, we are not just building a center—we are planting a flag for the Kingdom of God that will remain for generations.

Volunteers Already on the Ground:

On Monday, January 19 (public holiday), Sophia School stepped forward by releasing the first volunteer team of 80+ people to the KOMC site, a 5-hour mountainous journey one way. Some will serve one week, others two weeks. Teams will rotate weekly so the work continues without interruption.

The pledged offerings are already being invested in renting dozers, fuel, tools, and essential practical expenses on the ground.

God's people are moving together in unity. Now is the critical season to complete what He has begun.

#1. Urgent Priority – Water Well Project (Time-Sensitive):

Water is foundational for life, ministry, training, agriculture, and long-term sustainability at KOMC and the surrounding community. Here is the budget of the cost for water in below:

Drilling cost: NRs. 14,500/- per meter + 13% VAT (pipes included)

The drilling rig is from India and is available only for a very limited time

High daily taxes and new government regulations starting in April may close this window of opportunity.

Our site is new for the company and will serve as a showcase, so a favorable agreement was offered.

Stepping Out in Faith

By faith, we signed the agreement.

NRs. 700,000/- advance payment has been made

The drilling rig and compressor arrived yesterday morning

The machine was placed on the drilling ground in the afternoon. Drilling work began yesterday evening, following prayer by many leaders and volunteers working together at the KOMC site

Brother Mohan is leading the team on the ground. Due to poor mobile connectivity in this remote area, receiving photos and updates is challenging, but the work is actively progressing.

Still Needed:

Pump, cables, water tank, plumbing, and electrical systems

Total Water Well Project Estimate: **NRs. 4.2 Million.**

Current Shortfall: NRs. 3 Million.

Once this well is completed, we are also praying to install another well for the Karnali Riverside Church, located 30 km further down the valley, extending life-giving water to another unreached community. We are estimating that it will be less expensive compared to the first one. With drilling staff we are guessing it will be around 100 meters and the budget will be around **NRs. 2.5 Million.**

#2. Protective Fence Around the 5+ Acre Property:

This fence is critical to protect:

Vegetation and agriculture

Poultry and livestock

Long-term sustainability training for pastors and leaders

Purpose:

To model self-sustaining ministry—where leaders serve the Kingdom while responsibly stewarding land, food, and resources.

Fence Details (1,100 meters total):

Galvanized iron wire net with iron poles. The breakdown will be provided in your need/interest.

Total Cost: NRs. 3,856,500/-

#3. Earthquake-Resistant Church Hall:

Karnali is an earthquake-prone zone. We must build wisely and securely.

Size: 30 ft x 80 ft (including veranda)

Structure: steel pillars, reinforced concrete, brick walls

Steel truss with tin-sheet roofing

Materials Cost Only: NRs. 7 Million.

This hall will be the spiritual heart of KOMC—hosting worship, training, healing meetings, and leadership gatherings for the unreached.

#4. Semi-Concrete Rooms for Leaders:



for Leaders)

- (The foundation work of the rooms

Temporary structures have proven ineffective in this region.

Room size: 12 ft x 13 ft

Construction: brick, steel supports, wood, tin roofing

Cost of materials per room: NRs. 800K.

Phase 1: 4 rooms

Total Cost of Materials: NRs. 3.2 Million.

The workforce will be provided by GAN churches, reducing labor costs and strengthening ownership.

Future Phase (After Core Infrastructure):

Agricultural tools, seeds, plants

Poultry coops, goats, pigs, pens

Expanded accommodation for leaders

Moderate solar power system
